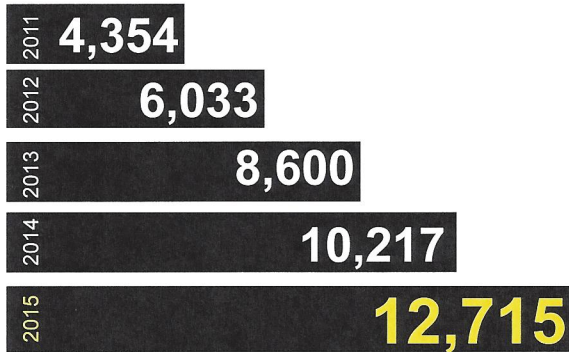

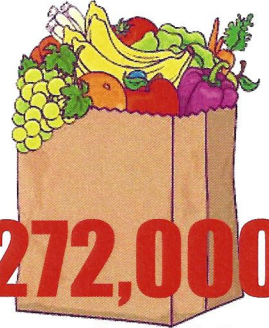
Thursdays 10-noon & 6-8pm

Individuals served

We provide families with basic food to last for **two weeks**. Our clients shop for their food as part of our Client Choice program, ensuring that the food we distributed is not wasted. We distribute food to families in need, in cooperation with the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma.

Our mission is to feed our local population that would normally go undernourished, such as kids, elderly and working families who are facing unusually difficult economic times.



- **4,025 families** fed in 2015, representing **12,715 individuals**.
- **2,498** more clients served in 2015 over 2014.
- **405** Thanksgiving baskets distributed in November.
- **80%** of clients are Edmond residents.
- Volunteers pick up thousands of pounds of donated food from local grocery stores every week so we can provide clients with fresh fruits, vegetables, eggs, milk and cheese.
